



# ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

It is strongly recommended that the green Clip-It Fixture be used for only 500 Balloons. PLEASE THROW AWAY YOUR OLD CLIP-IT FIXTURE.

**1** Place clip on the fixture, opening facing up. It can point either direction as long as the opening faces up.

**2** Fill the container with warm water if possible. Cold water is ok too.

Dip the pump as illustrated making sure the intake valve is under the surface of the water. Then pull back on the handle to draw the water into the pump. The ideal amount of water is approximately 1-1/2 oz (45 ml)

**3** Insert the nozzle into the balloon, so that tip is in the center of the balloon.

Hold it securely with one hand. Push water into balloon and continue to pump air into balloon until it is 3" (80 mm), the size of baseball.

**4** Hold neck of the balloon securely with one hand and twist 2 ~ 3 times with other hand. This insures a tight seal.

2 ~ 3 times

**5** Hold rubber string and the neck of the balloon with both hands. Then **S-T-R-E-T-C-H (VERY IMPORTANT!)**

**STRETCH!**

**6** Place the stretched string and neck inside the opening of the clip. **CONTINUE TO STRETCH AS YOU PUSH the clip down** the shaft, sealing the balloon and attaching the string.

**7** Make a loop at the opposite end of the string.

**8** All set to go!

**NOTE,**  
 If the clip breaks, you have not stretched the balloon and string tight enough.  
 If the balloon leaks, you (a) have not stretched the balloon and string tight enough or (b) you need to replace the fixture.
