Suzuki Latex, manufacturer of the official YoYo Balloon, declares that the history of the official YoYo Balloon verifies the ultimate safety for children over 8 years old. In the past 50 years there has not been a case of injury formally reported to Suzuki Latex as a result of playing the official YoYo Balloon.

What is the YoYo Balloon? It is a 3" **natural latex** balloon, inflated with air and a half ounce of water. It is tied with a thin rubber string attched at the neck of the balloon. It is sold as a kit, and assembled by the customer. The YoYo Balloon has been used at public gatherings such as fairs, carnivals, flea markets and birthday parties etc., and celebrations for 50 years in Japan and is still being used all over the world today.

Recently, China produced a similar product called the "YOYO BALL". Do not confuse the YoYo Balloon with the YOYO BALL. The construction and materials of the YOYO BALL is much different than that of the YoYo Balloon, even though playing with it is much the same. The YOYO BALL is made of a syntheic rubber ball and a thick molded rubber strings. It comes fully assembled. These materials are much heavier than the YoYo Balloon and become a weapon when swung around. As a result, the YOYO BALL has been banned from some states and countries.
